FOOD CO-OP

We are excited to announce that Bucaan Community House is working with Co-op Program so that the community can access fresh vegetable boxes, frozen (pictured above), jams and relishes.



There are three vegetable boxes available for \$10, \$20 and \$40, plus a \$10 soup box and a \$15 roast vegetable box. For your convenience, you can also order ready made frozen meals for \$3.50, \$20 meat trays and free-range eggs for \$3 per dozen.

Orders and payment are due Thursday weekly for collection the following Wednesday from 12pm onwards at the Bucaan Community House. There is an additional fee of \$1.00 per order if you would like your produce delivered to your home.

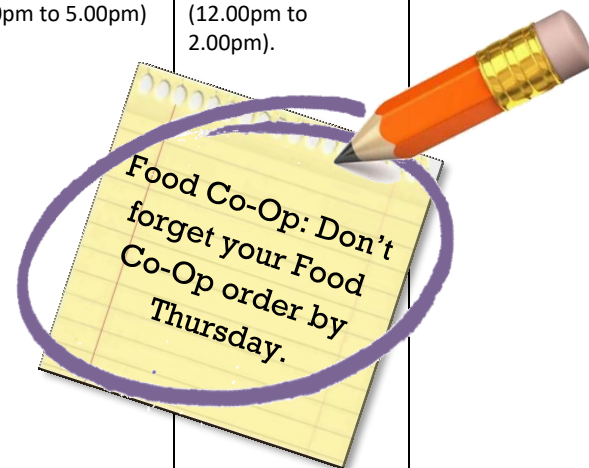
